Photography projects are set on a monthly basis which allows members to take their photos anytime during the allotted month. The projects are usually planned in December for the following year. All photos presented for the yearly projects are to be taken during that calendar year.

Meetings (currently held via Zoom due to Covid-19 restrictions) are held at predetermined times. At these meetings, the previous months' photos are shared, and general discussion about the photos takes place.

To assist members with their photographic skills, training of a photographic nature can be included at these meetings.

Following the monthly meeting, all submitted photographs are uploaded to Dropbox which can be accessed by all group members.

The group undertakes annual photography trips to various locations. Over recent years the group has visited Clare, Waikerie, Barmera, Flinders Ranges and this year we travelled to Mount Gambier. These trips are decided on consensus by all members of the group.

The group is a no fees group (apart from your Retire Active SA membership fee) and group communication is primarily via email.
